VIII visited to Pohara Forest where they learnt about eco system, biodiversity and importance of conservation. Our teachers have planned for them very well in advance so that the child can get the first sight information and experience.

Children also visited relevant areas so as to gain more information and get direct exposure from the field trip. Students are quite capable of expressing what they see & what they want to.

A mini marathon was also organised for all the students on the occasion of National Sports day to promote fitness and sportsmanship.

Regarding Workshops: Workshops on some important concepts like Financial literacy, Cyber Security were organised for the students of Std. VI to VIII to Aquent them with the on going issues in todays society.

We also conducted **PTM** every month in which parents can see their wards progress and can give us the necessary feedback. Thank you once again all the parents for your valuable and constructive feedback. We have moved ahead taking all your feedback in our day to day account.

We have a headed technology as all our classrooms are techfriendly having ICR boards. And all our teachers have trained well to use these boards.

Academics being a prime interest for us we ensure that our students are being provided with the best facilities to equip them for the successful life in the years ahead.

Consequently we are offering mentoring; we have successfully conducted the Olympiad exams for our students thereby in every subject to explore beyond the classrooms and the textbooks. Through this their capacity to face the challenging questions was determined. I feel very proud to announce that 73 students in NSO, 159 students in IMO and 71 students in IEO have passed with flying colours and bagged 14 Gold medals in NSO, 21 Gold medals in IMO and 12 Gold medals in IEO respectively and some of our students also appeared for the second level examination.

Mst. Prerak Bodakhe from Std. V bagged Gold medals in all the 3 exams. Mst. Aarav Thakare from Std. V, Mst. Siddant Damodar from Std. V, Mst. Aaradhya Damodar from Std. VI, Mst. Mahesh Ambekar, Mst. Shring Deshmukh from Std. I, Mst. Dhairya Nawandar from Std. III bagged Gold medals in NSO and IEO exams respectively.

We have also organised for the Eye check-up of all our students and in the forthcoming session we will be tying up with one of the reputed medical institutions for regular medical check-up of our children. Also, a health check-up was organised for both parents and teachers.

Not, just academics, but hobbies and sports are also our major concern. Expression in the form of music; dance and playing instruments are mode to peace. As a part of the hobby program to be taken in the school we showcase the various categories creative activities to enable the students to excel their previous standard; competitions are held from time to time. Students at SNIS are encouraged towards vocal music were students appeared for the vocal music Interschool patriotic singing competition organized by Lokmat Campus club, wherein, our children put their benchmark and showed their hidden talent and grabbed 1st position in group B and a consolation in group A.

Also, in the Interschool musical competition **Jallosh Lok kalecha** organised by **Bal rangbhumi parishad, Mumbai** wherein our students stood 2nd in Group song competition and 3rd position in Solo Dholak performance and 4th position in Solo singing. They are also encouraged to play keyboard, Tabla, Harmonium, Guitar and we have also formed our best Band troop.

In Sports Ms. Ravya Sontakke from Std. IV bagged Bronze medal in 17th Mini State Fencing Championship @ Sambhaji Nagar. She also stood 13th @ All India level in 7th Child cup & 13th Mini National Fencing Championship. Next Ms. Kanika Shirao bagged Gold medal in 51st Junior State Level Aquatic Championship. And recently, Mst. Kartikesh Sharma, Mst. Vaishnav Bhendkar, Mst. Siddhant Damodar, Mst. Aaditya Barde, Mst. Raghav Rathi and Mst. Parth Umale Bagged 1st Championship @ State level Minigolf competition under 14 boys team. In mix doubles under 17 Ms. Ekta Adak & Mst. Nayan Deshmukh bagged Bronze medal each.

Recently we celebrated our **Annual Sports Week** in which our students enthusiastically participated & represented the yoga drill, flower drill, balloon drill, wands drill, Flag drill, pompom drill, lazim drill, dumbbell drill and various types of races, team games like kho-kho, cricket, langadi, kabaddi, which mesmerised the present parents. Not only this, we have also introduced games such as Rope & pole Mallkhamb, Chess, Carom, basketball, minigolf, skating, fencing & athletics and ofcourse in the forthcoming session will be focusing on Table-tennis and Archery as well.

We believe in making students with all round development, yoga & meditation have taken a new rule in today's society and it is being valued for its neuropathic nature, the realisation therapy introduced to our

students through yoga, sharpens their mental capacity by allowing them to balance their emotions and attain self-control.
